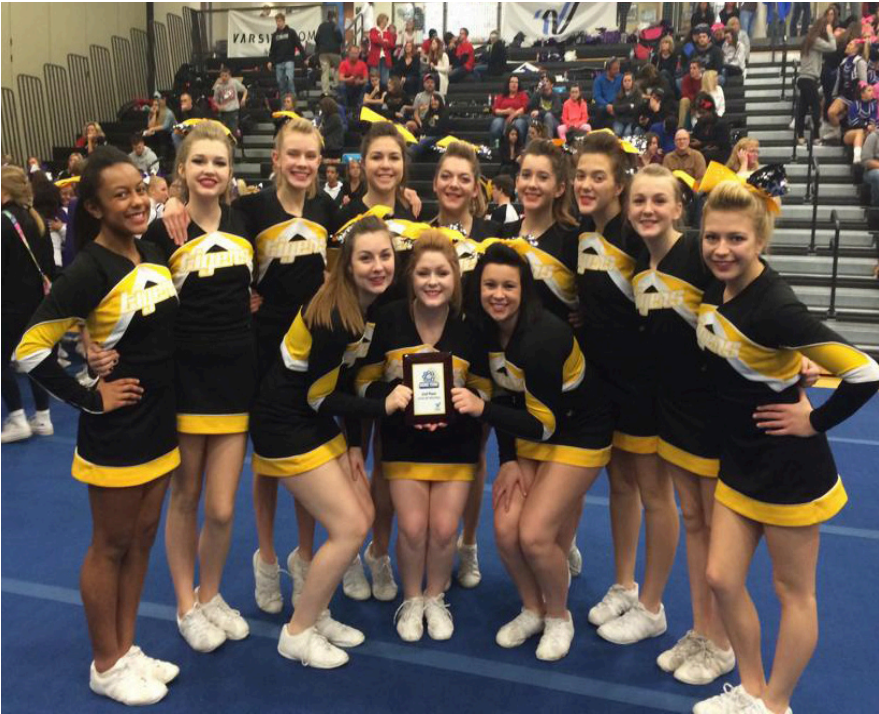

“I feel very fortunate and blessed to have been part of the Fort Osage R-1 School District these past seven years. I am extremely appreciative of the experiences and opportunities in working together with an amazing staff and administrative team. This is my 30th year working in special education and I am proud to be able to retire from the Fort Osage family,” said Lanier.

Prior to coming to Fort Osage, Lanier served as the Director of Special Programs in the Warrensburg School District. In addition, she was an adjunct teacher at the University of Central Missouri Special Education Department. Lanier has also served as an Educational Diagnostician, a special education process coordinator, an early childhood special education teacher and a behavioral interventionist for the Lee’s Summit School District. Prior to Lee’s Summit Lanier taught in the Belton School District at Hillcrest Elementary serving as the class-within-a-class and resource learning disabilities teacher.

Upon retirement Lanier will again teach for the University of Central Missouri in the Special Education department.

Mr. John Schuler, principal of Osage Trail Middle School, has announced his retirement effective June 30, 2015.

Schuler has been Principal at Osage Trail Middle School since August 2011. Prior to assuming that position, Schuler served as the Assistant Principal, and was a teacher in the Fort Osage School District. Starting in 1987, he has taught 6th thru 9th

The students will perform on Saturday, December 13 at Park Hill High School.

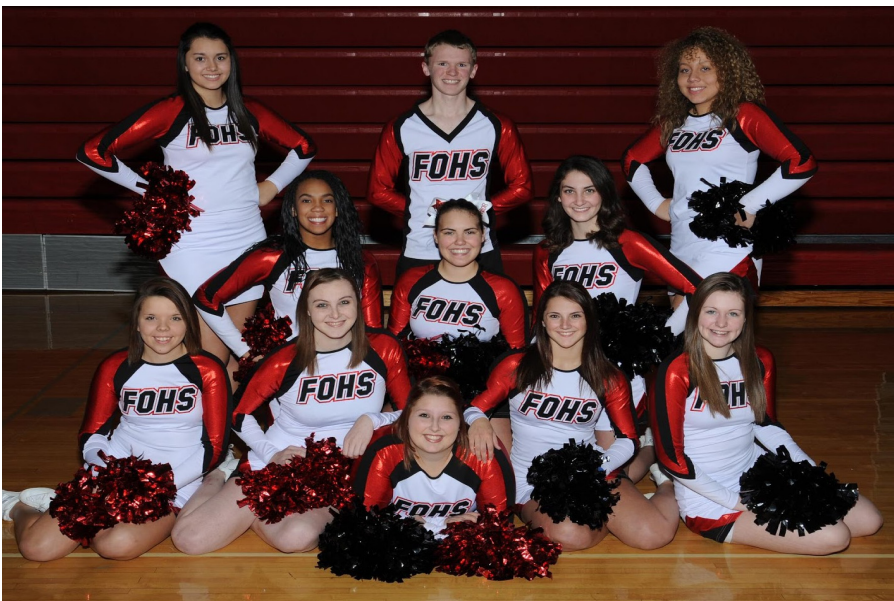

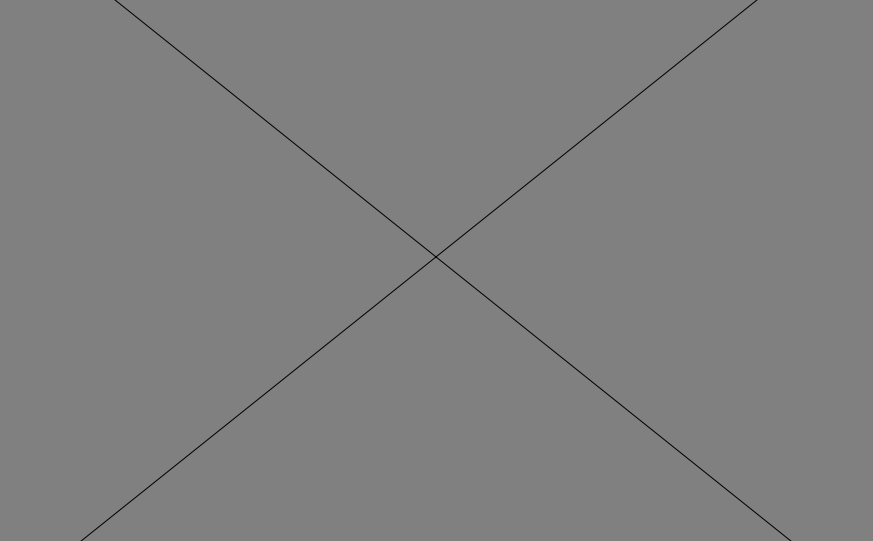
